- Volunteer Days were attended in Ely and Lund

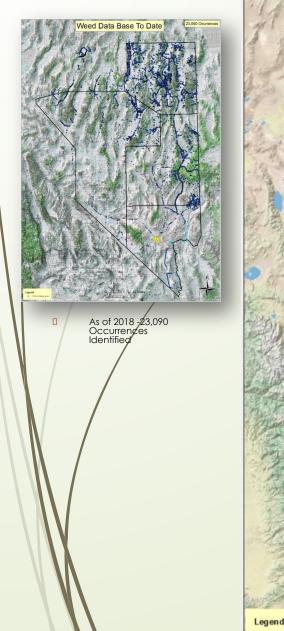

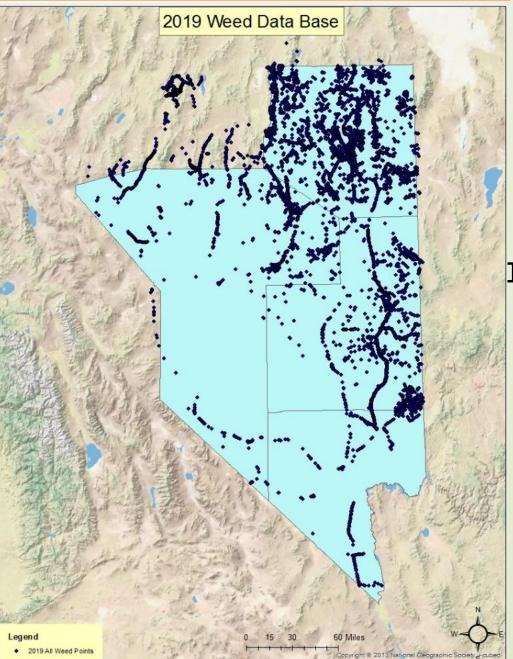


- Kinross Bald Mountain Mine 33.53 acres included dyer's woad, bull thistle, and musk thistle
- Bureau of Land Management of the Goshute Cave Fire 1.45 infested acres included scotch thistle, musk thistle, hoary cress and spotted knapweed



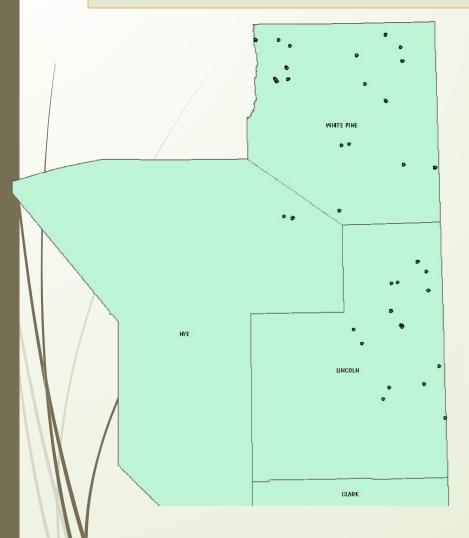
